Fig. 75—Adaptation of the well-known Felch Chart to illustrate how far this method of line breeding can be utilized in the case of fowls that are selected by yearly trapnest performance, as well as for other desirable qualifications. The black lines and circles show how far it is practical to go, provided the original pair of birds live long enough; the dim lines show the balance of the Felch Chart, a use of which takes too long for the poultry culturist who must wait for the trapnest to give its annual report on each crop of pullets.
